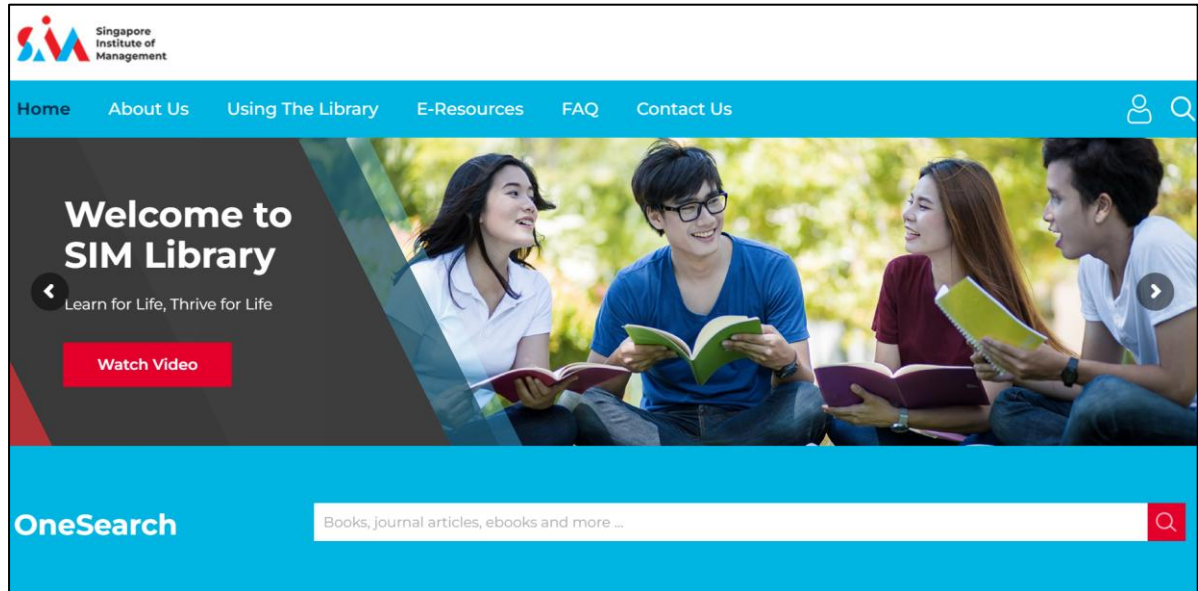
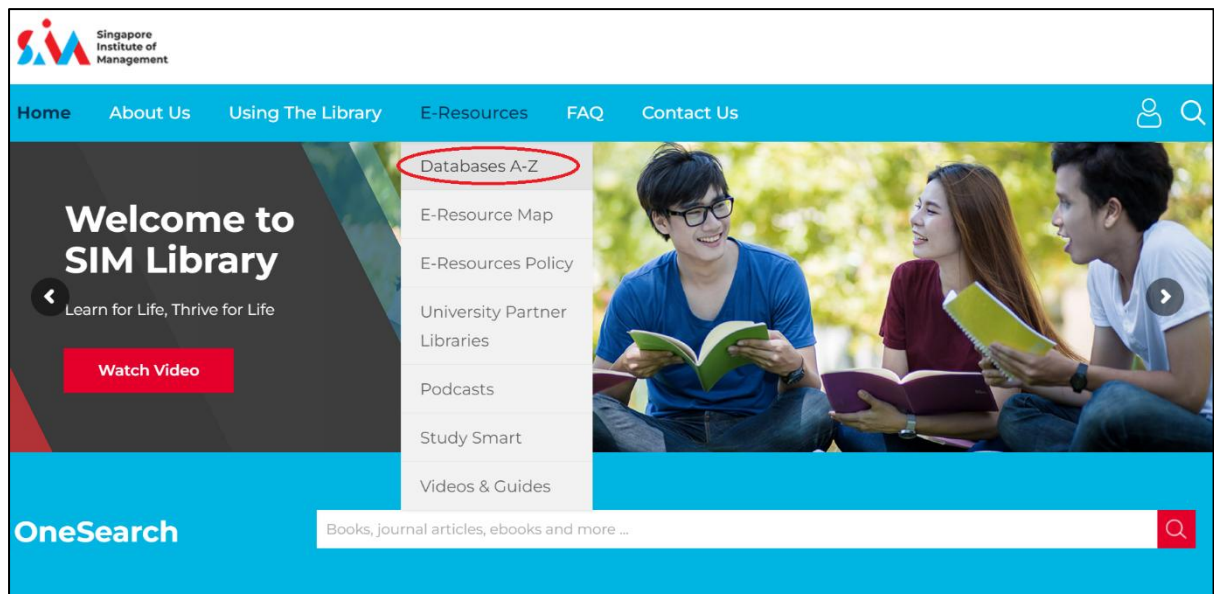


How to access Library E-Resources?

Step 1: Visit SIM Library Website – library.sim.edu.sg or click [HERE](#).

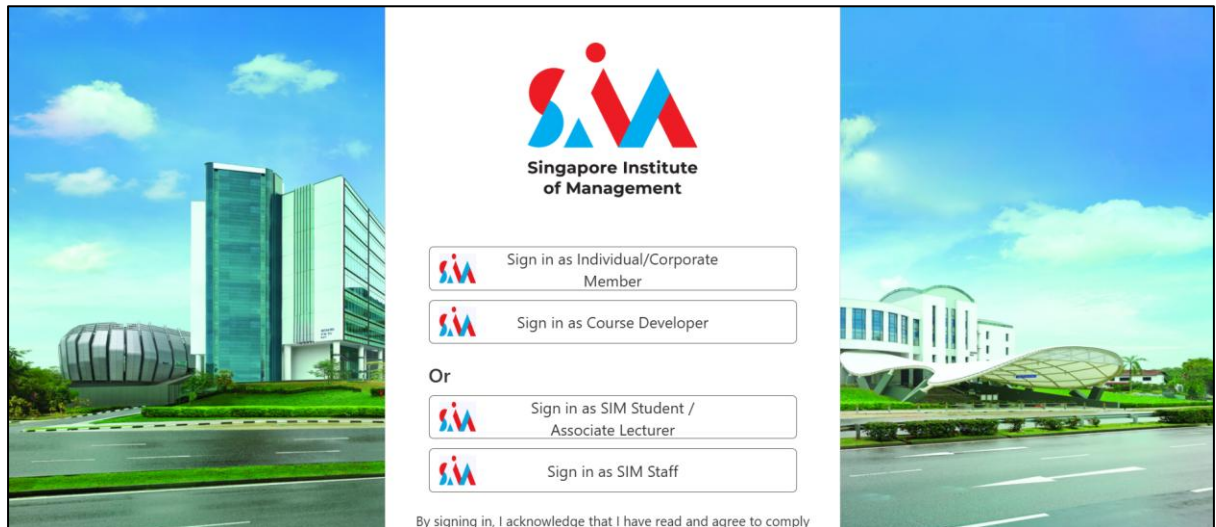


Step 2: Click on E-Resources > Databases A-Z

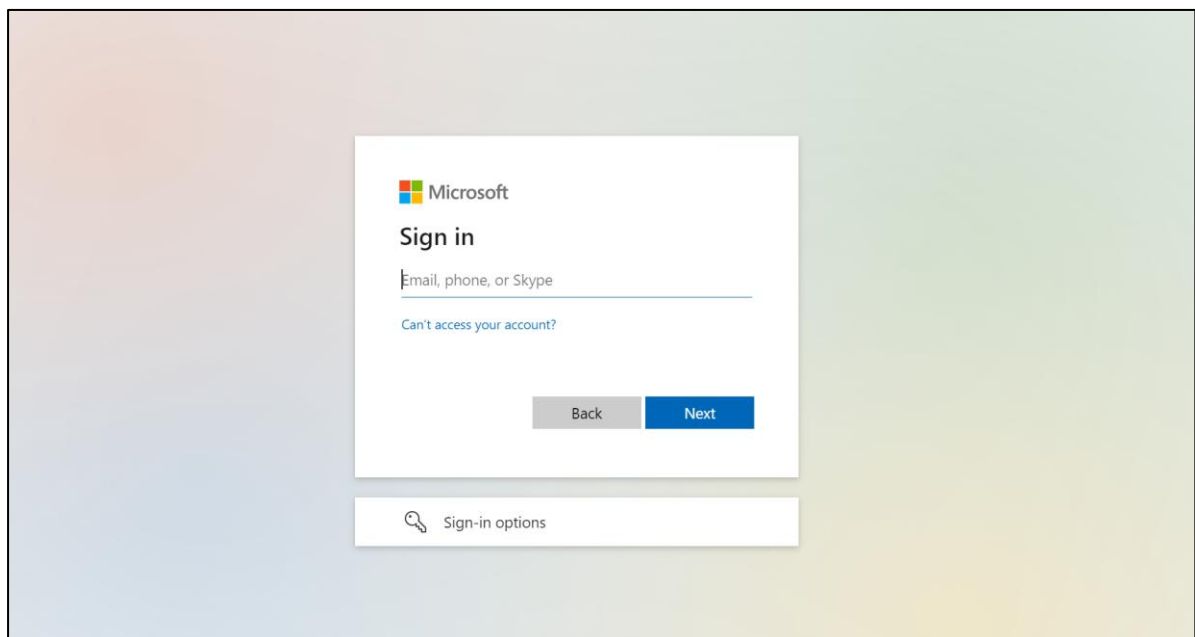


Step 3: Log in to your account.

- a) Choose your sign-in category (i.e. if you are an SIM student, sign in as SIM student. If you are a staff, sign in as SIM staff)



- b) Use your SIM email and password to log in (eg: name001@mymail.sim.edu.sg)



Step 4: Once logged in, you will see the word “Sign out”. Click on the E-Resources (Factiva) to browse.
